OVERVIEW

The City of Norfolk is dedicated to ensuring safe and accessible roadways for all users, recognizing that reaching your destination safely is a fundamental right. To achieve this goal, the City is committed to developing a comprehensive safety action plan, funded by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Safe Streets and Roads for All program.

This initiative will reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries by working with the community to:

- identify challenges
- develop effective strategies
- implement solutions

The Norfolk Safety Action Plan aims to provide accessible and equitable multi-modal transportation options throughout the City, promoting a safer, more inclusive, and connected transportation network for all.

The key objectives of the Norfolk Safety Action Plan are:

1. Reduce roadway fatalities and serious injuries to zero
2. Improve safety for all road users, including pedestrians, bicyclists, scooter users, motorists, and public transportation users
3. Enhance the safety of vulnerable road users, such as pedestrians, bicyclists, and older adults
4. Foster a collaborative approach to roadway safety among local governments, transportation agencies, and community stakeholders

Through the Norfolk Safety Action Plan, the City aims to achieve "Vision Zero," reducing roadway fatalities and serious injuries to zero.

May-June 2024

DATA COLLECTION: Gathering data to understand our roadway safety challenges



July-August 2024

SAFETY AND EQUITY ANALYSIS: Analyzing data to identify areas of concern and disparities

COUNTERMEASURE IDENTIFICATION & PRIORITIZATION: Identifying and prioritizing solutions



November-December 2024

DOCUMENTATION: Compiling the plan and recommendations
