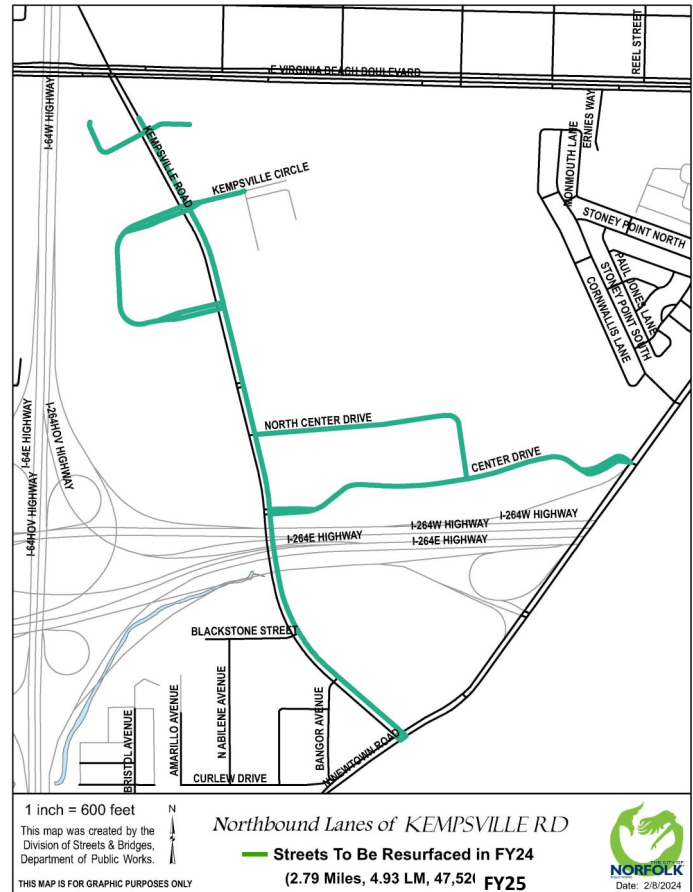
CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS/TRAFFIC

- **Update for Tropical Storm Debby: Due to inclement weather, the Kempsville Resurfacing project will move to daytime work. The daytime work will begin on Friday, August 9th and continue through Sunday, August 11th from 7 AM to 5 PM.**
- Off-duty police and flaggers may assist with traffic.
- Work will be performed at night between the hours of 7:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M. Motorists should expect alternating lane closures, intermittent traffic stoppages and are encouraged to take alternate routes to avoid construction.
- "Watch for "No Stopping/No Parking" signs. Flyers will be placed on vehicles parked on the street, 24 hours in advance. Vehicles will be towed, at owner's expense, if not moved before 7:00 PM on the day work begins.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
- Trash and recycling services will continue as normal.
