5499 Granby Street

PROJECT INFORMATION

This project will stabilize approximately 270 linear feet of eroding bank on the shore of the northern branch of the Lafayette River. Multiple rock sills with the sand-backfilled areas will be installed to reduce wave impacts. Marsh grasses will be installed behind the sills, and native wildflowers, grasses, trees, and shrubs will be planted on the slopes above the newly constructed marshes.



SCOPE OF WORK

Restore approximately 0.14 acres of tidal marsh.
