The City of Norfolk is rehabilitating the Brambleton Avenue pedestrian bridge near the Norfolk Public Health Center and EVMS. The project will include demolition and replacement of the concrete walkway, replacement of select structural steel framing, new checkered steel plate stair risers and landings, a new roof system, and new paint.

- Structural steel framing replacement
- New checkered plate stair treads and landings
- Roof replacement
- Fresh paint
