

BROAD CREEK BRIDGE REHABILITATION

LOCATION

Virginia Beach Boulevard, Broad Creek Bridge over the Elizabeth River

PROJECT INFORMATION

The City of Norfolk is rehabilitating the Virginia Beach Boulevard over Broad Creek bridge. The project will include removing a portion of the bridge, sidewalk, and railing. A new section of bridge and sidewalk will be recast in concrete and a new railing system installed. A sealant will be applied to the concrete.

SCOPE OF WORK

- Remove a portion of the bridge, sidewalk and railing
- Recast new section of bridge and sidewalk with concrete
- New railing system installed
- Sealant applied to concrete

CONSTRUCTION/TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- The outside lane heading eastbound will be closed for approximately 5 months.
- The outside lane heading westbound will be closed for approximately 5 months.
- There will be several weeks where the outside two lanes will be closed while a crane is staged on the bridge.
