

HAVEN CREEK LIVING SHORELINE MAINTENANCE

LOCATION

Project area spans the inlet between Llewellyn Avenue and Mayflower Road in Colonial Place, accessible via the Haven Creek Boat Ramp at 4001 Llewellyn Avenue.



PROJECT INFORMATION

The goal of the project is to improve drainage in Colonial Place by dredging and making necessary repairs to each of the outfall structures that drain into Haven Creek from the neighborhood. Additionally, the existing tidal marshes in the project area will be expanded.

SCOPE OF WORK

Dredge and repair six Haven Creek outfalls, remove and dispose of approximately 1,500 cubic yards of dredge material; restore approximately .59 acres of tidal marsh in Haven Creek.
