Citywide: along Granby Street, Ocean View Avenue, and Tidewater Drive.

Project Benefits

The project will install or enhance up to 80 pedestrian crossings along Granby Street, Ocean View Avenue, and Tidewater Drive.

Scope of Work

The safety improvements include, but are not limited to, crosswalk visibility enhancements, rectangular rapid flashing beacons (RRFB), pedestrian hybrid beacons (PHB), leading pedestrian interval (LPI), medians with pedestrian refuge islands, enhanced stop signs, stop bars, and advance warning signs.
