

LEAVE AND BENEFITS

AT THE CITY OF NORFOLK

Work-Life Balance

- Paid Family Leave – up to six weeks for an FMLA approved claim for a child, spouse, or parent
- Short- and Long-Term Disability (STD/LTD) City Paid Insurance after one year, with optional STD or LTD Gap coverage available upon hire. Sworn Public Safety can enroll in optional STD and/or LTD Disability coverage.
- Generous Paid Leave options, which include a total of 29 days (232 hours) annually:
 - 13 days of Official City Holidays
 - 2 days of Wellness Leave
 - 1 day of Birthday Leave
 - 1 day of Diversity Leave
 - 12 days of Annual Leave
 - 12 days of Sick Leave
 - 3 days of Bereavement Leave, as needed
 - ½ day of Volunteer Leave

Financial

- \$3,000 referral bonus for general employees
- \$5,000 referral bonus for Sworn Employees, Public Safety Telecommunicator Call Taker and Telecommunicator I-III
- Employer-paid parking
- Life insurance through VRS, set at twice the employee's salary
- Automatic enrollment in Virginia Retirement System (VRS)
- If you elect the HSA Plan, the City will contribute pre-tax dollars on or about Jan. 10. For contribution amounts see Benefits below (click Spending Accounts).
- Dependent Care Flexible Spending Account with \$2,500 match, for qualifying childcare/dependent care expenses
- Optional Legal Services Plan and Identity Theft Protection

Career

- Educational Assistance after six months to support self-development and lifelong learning, includes:
 - Tuition Reimbursement - for the pursuit of study, degrees or certificate programs
 - Professional Certification and Licensure Reimbursement - covers prep courses and exam fees
 - Commercial Driver's License (CDL) Training Program – for positions that require or may require a CDL
 - Professional Development training throughout the year
